SP was a big player in the 1980 and 1990s intermodal scene, with their attractive "Sunset" logo and speed lettering adorning many containers. What if they had survived into the 53' era?

Seatrains was a pioneer in the intermodal field, shipping entire loaded railcars by boat in 1928. Though they went bankrupt in 1981, the distinctive logo still looks good, as though they had survived into the modern era.

### PROTOTYPE AND BACKGROUND INFO:

An intermodal container (also known as a container, freight container, ISO container, shipping container, hi-cube container, box, sea container, container van) is a standardized reusable steel box. Intermodal containers are used to store and move materials and products efficiently and securely in the global containerized intermodal freight transport system. "Intermodal" indicates that the container can be used across various modes of transport, (from ship to rail to truck) without unloading and reloading its contents. Lengths of containers, which each have a unique ISO 6346 reporting mark, vary from 8 to 60 feet (2.44 to 18.29 m) and heights from 8 feet (2.438 m) to 9 feet 6 inches (2.896 m). There are about 17 million intermodal containers in the world of varying types to suit different cargoes.
