

In the early 1970's EMD introduced their -2 series line which essentially was a program of upgrading many of their existing product offerings with new modularized electrical systems and other improvements. The SD45 was upgraded to the SD45-2. Santa Fe would eventually purchase 90 of them with first group arriving in the blue & yellow "pinstripe" scheme that was being phased out in favor of the new yellow bonnet scheme. Some of the last units in this order came with factory installed air conditioners.







PROTOTYPE SPECIFIC INFORMATION

The SD45-2 was an initial success; it was a complete improvement or upgrade as part of EMD's "Dash 2" line; it had little to almost absolutely no flaws during the early stages of production and during the model's official introduction. It was both popular and compatible with the original SD45 as well, with it's large 20-cylinder engine. The SD45-2 lasted somewhat longer than most SD45 units on various owners roster's.

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
