






In the 1970s, many shortline railroads purchased brand new boxcars to take advantage of the "Incentive Per Diem" put into place by the government. At this time, if a railroad increased its boxcar fleet, it was allowed to charge other railroads instead of the customer, for their daily use. Many shortlines saw this as another way to earn revenue beyond their home rails. Unfortunately the program didn't work out exactly as the government envisioned; it was then abolished. Many of the shortlines that bought into "Incentive Per Diem" boxcars, cancelled their lease and the new boxcars scattered all over North America. Many were hastily patched as the orphaned boxcars found new home railroads.




